What You Will Do/Need (Job Summary)

Occasional/As Needed Volunteers assist in a variety of roles to promote an encouraging, safe, and healthy environment for the ASH residents.

Occasional/As Needed Volunteers for the ASH Safe House may include:

- Worship Leaders
- Leaders for fun group activities with the residents
- Individuals teaching an expertise or life skill
- Small Group/Bible Study leaders
- Assistants for transporting residents to programming, appointments, etc.
- Group interior cleaning/organizing projects
- Providing seasonal yard work/landscaping projects
- Assisting with building maintenance; handyman jobs, as needed

Responsibilities (Essential Duties and Responsibilities)

- Coordinates volunteer activity with the assigned ASH staff person, while communicating with the participating resident's Case Manager for approved scheduling
- Utilizes a particular gifting or skill to provide spiritual, emotional, or practical improvement to the Adult Safe
- Fulfills all pertinent prerequisites, including trauma-informed training and required paperwork
- Keeps the Case Manager informed of any safety concerns pertaining to the resident and/or other individuals at the Adult Safe House
- Logs volunteer activity at the completion of each visit using the online form provided on the RAHAB website: www.rahab-ministries.org/volunteer-time

Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required)

- Possesses an understanding of RAHAB's mission and vision
- Strong commitment to confidentiality
- Able to maintain a regular time commitment to the agreed-upon volunteer activity
- Must have a valid Ohio Driver's License, and deemed eligible to transport ASH residents (when applicable) per RAHAB's insurance company
- Must submit and pass a Federal Background check at the volunteer's expense (if volunteer activity involves interaction with the ASH residents)



- Growing relationship with Christ
- Trauma informed
- General knowledge of human trafficking field and effects of sexual exploitation
- Sensitivity to the process of achieving sobriety
- Able to engage both Christians and non-Christians
- Prior leadership experience within a ministry context
- Prior volunteer experience within RAHAB Ministries

- Possesses a heart to serve
- Exhibits the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)
- Trustworthy and consistent
- Hopeful and positive

Physical Demands and Work Environment

May vary depending on volunteer activity

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work

- Volunteer; Occasional or as-needed
- Frequency and duration of visits will vary depending on volunteer activity

Travel

Travel to and from the Adult Safe House is required; each volunteer uses his/her personal vehicle for transportation, unless permission is given for volunteer to transport a resident using a RAHAB vehicle.
