What You Will Do/Need (Job Summary)

Mentors have the important role of coming alongside the resident to provide encouragement, a godly example, and support in a relational context. This is done through consistent interaction and scheduled activities that are enjoyed mutually by the mentor and resident.

Responsibilities (Essential Duties and Responsibilities)

- Plans activities with the resident, while communicating with the resident's Case Manager for approved scheduling
- Engages the resident with active listening, ensuring that confidentiality and a safe listening space are high priority
- Shares life experiences that provide support and meaningful connection in a non-judgmental and sensitive manner
- Keeps the Case Manager informed of any safety concerns pertaining to the resident and/or other individuals at the Adult Safe House
- Logs volunteer activity at the completion of each visit using the online form provided on the RAHAB website: www.rahab-ministries.org/volunteer-time

Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required)

- Mature relationship with Christ
- Possesses a passion consistent with RAHAB's mission and vision
- Strong commitment to confidentiality
- Excellent communication skills
- Able to maintain a regular time commitment with the resident
- Must be 21 years of age or older
- Must have a valid Ohio Driver's License
- Must submit and pass a Federal Background check

What Will Make You Special (Preferred Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities)

- Trauma informed
- General knowledge of human trafficking field and effects of sexual exploitation
- Personal experience with successful recovery and/or overcoming hardships
- Able to engage both Christians and non-Christians
- Prior experience with mentoring and/or leadership within a ministry context
- Prior volunteer experience within RAHAB Ministries

- Emotional maturity
- Able to create, enforce, and honor boundaries
- Good listener
- Trustworthy and consistent
- Hopeful and positive

Physical Demands and Work Environment

May vary depending on mentoring activities

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work

Volunteer; Minimum of three times a month for a minimum of one hour each visit – frequency and duration of visits may vary depending on resident's preference

Travel

Travel to and from the Adult Safe House is required for off-site mentoring activities; each mentor uses her personal vehicle for transportation.
