What You Will Do/Need (Job Summary)

This position involves prayerfully ministering inside of strip clubs to express the love of Jesus to our friends that dance. These volunteers are fearless, Spirit led, and are willing to consistently show up to formulate relationships.

Responsibilities (Essential Duties and Responsibilities)

Administrative:

- Able to remember conversations to record after leaving club so team can pray
- Log volunteer hours after
- Communicate number of women seen, spoken to, or referred to RAHAB & send them to Becca ASAP
- Recording team notes
- Adhere to confidentiality agreement
- Communicate Jesus stories to RAHAB staff & the donors providing gifts/meals for your team

Direct Care:

- Foster a safe and encouraging environment for the women you're visiting
- Follow all safety protocols and procedures in order to maintain safety and security
- Intentionally listen well. Make sure the woman knows you are not judging her, you are there to listen & show the love of Jesus.
- Establish healthy emotional boundaries
- Come to each gathering prayed up and ready to pour out

Coordination:

- Work closely and communicate regularly with other volunteers on your team, as well as recording all info and sending it to Becca.
- Ability to plan ahead for future outreach dates
- Speak with those coordinating food and gifts

Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required)

- Mature relationship with Christ
- Empathy when it comes to our women. We may not agree with their choices, but we have no idea what's led them to make these.
- Ability to support members of your team despite differences



- Willing to discuss and problem solve conflict that may arise on your team
- Humble, team player with strong integrity
- Punctual
- Trauma informed and the ability to perform trauma informed care
- General knowledge of human trafficking field and effects of sexual exploitation
- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal
- Must be 21 years of age or older
- Must have a valid Ohio Driver’s License
- Must submit and pass a Federal Background check

What Will Make You Special (Preferred Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities)

- Trauma informed
- Unshockable (not easily swayed by surroundings)
- Military or Police background
- Familiar with listening to the Holy Spirit & obeying what He says
- Previous experience and knowledge in human trafficking field

Characteristics of the Position (Competencies)

- Seeks to foster a positive and encouraging environment
- Strives to maintain a culture of love and respect among the team

Physical Demands and Work Environment

Light physical demands. Possible exposure to drugs, alcohol, weapons, gang activity, etc.

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work

Once a month commitment. 3-4 hours on a Friday or Saturday evening.

Local travel to whatever team you are placed on
